Special Education Consultant

Our new Special Education Consultation Service, led by Jeff Forman, MSW, has two components: a Parent Support option and a PPT Facilitation and Collaborative Mediation option. Parent Support provides expert support to parents struggling with navigating the process of special education. PPT Facilitation and Collaborative Mediation provides parents and educational teams with an option for unique, non-binding, collaborative facilitation/mediation.

Speech and Language Evaluation

Speech and Language Evaluations are completed by Stephanie Bendiske, CCC-SLP, BCBA. Referrals can be generated privately or by school districts. Evaluations can focus on speech, language, and social communication. Recommendations would include how to incorporate needs into the school environment and how to move the student forward.

Parent Management Training (PMT)

PMT is an evidence- based program for children with moderate to severe behavioral difficulties. This short term treatment program is for the caregiver to learn strategies to manage these behaviors over the long term. Families will work with our social worker Jessica Hatch, LMSW to help guide them on long term solutions.

Integrated Psychiatric and Neuropsychological Evaluation (IPNE)

The IPNE is a multi-disciplinary evaluation that combines neuropsychological and psychiatric evaluations for students with more complex needs. The neuropsychologist and psychiatrist collaborate in order to provide an integrated formulation of the findings and to generate comprehensive recommendations for intervention both in the child's school and in the community. The psychiatric evaluation portion is conducted by Dr. Lisa Namerow. Drs. Carr, Isenberg, or Lord complete the neuropsychological evaluation piece. Referrals for IPNEs are accepted from school districts, parents, and community providers.
